This Registered Practical Nurse is a new role is focused on working with on-site lead physician and TVFHT's Clinical and Operations Departments to offer patient care (blood pressure checks, ear syringing, injections, suture/staple removal, TB skin tests) in a primary care setting. This role will require **evening hours**, with vacation aligning with lead physicians schedule, and following TVFHT Health & Safety policies and procedures.

Requirements, Skills, and Abilities:

- Current registration with the College of Nurses of Ontario
- Work directly with a family physician and able to work independently and provide episodic care under a medical order or directive in person and through virtual tools
- Provide administrative and clinical support for research and educational activities
- Demonstrated knowledge of and commitment to the principles of patient and family centred care
- Knowledge and experience working collaboratively with community resources and home based nursing care
- At least 2 years' experience in **primary care** with knowledge of the Ontario immunization schedules, injection therapies, minor wound care and some chronic diseases.
- Drawing of basic bloodwork and preparation for transport to laboratory for analysis.
- Assisting in the support and education of medical learners
- Assisting in the implementation of clinical research
- Experience with triage, counselling, explaining basic test results and patient advice
- Reports and records accurately and appropriately using an electronic medical record and other required medical software and databases
- Maintain accurate EMR Health Maintenance Plans to ensure patient compliance to timelines for health promotion, disease prevention programs such as pap smears, mammograms, FOB testing, bone density and diabetes care.
- Participate in the processing of insurance forms, legal requests, notes and other required documentation.
- Ensure adequate stock and appropriate storage of immunizations
- Order all medical supplies and maintain clean, orderly and well-stocked examination rooms.
- Case management skills and care coordination skills considered an asset
